## **Reggio Curriculum**

FMCP is a Reggio-Inspired learning community. The Reggio-Inspired Approach focuses on student-centered constructivism that allows the children to have self-directed, experiential learning in a safe, natural environment. We meet or exceed the state and licensing requirements for our A+ accreditation. Here at FMCP, we realize that children form their personalities at an early age and learn to express their ideas in various ways. We strive to allow the children to learn through exploration and discovery while learning and following the principles of respect, responsibility, and community. At FMCP, we encourage children to play and explore in nature. Children will often come home with dirty clothes from immersive play.

## **Sign in and Out**

Please remember to sign your child in and out every day by scanning the code at the school's entrance or by the classroom's doors. We will be more than glad to help you if you need assistance. All children must be signed in for the day by 9am.

## **Personal Belongings**

Your child will need 1 blanket, three sets of clothes, and five bibs. Please put your child's name on the items listed above. Every Friday, your child's blanket will be sent home to be washed unless they become soiled before Friday. You are responsible for ensuring they return on Mondays or the next day if sent home before Friday. We provide and wash sheets and extra blankets, unless parents prefer to bring their own.

## **Sanitation**

At FMCP, we know the importance of a safe and sanitary environment for our children. Classroom toys and equipment are sanitized daily with a bleach water solution. Once a toy goes into a child's mouth, it is sanitized before another child uses it. Our changing table is sanitized after each use, and we practice good hand washing techniques. You will find our toddler room is always clean and well organized.

### **Cubbies and Communication**

Please remember to check cubbies (and hooks for soiled clothing) and your child's Brightwheel **daily** because it contains essential information and communications from the office.

We strive for consistency between school and at-home practices. Please feel comfortable at any time to share information with our teachers about your child's development or any concerns you may have. Each day we prepare an informative report via Brightwheel, listing all information regarding feeding, napping, diapering, and what your child especially learned and enjoyed that day.
